They serve a lovely carvery with a choice of three meats, usually pork, beef, turkey, gammon and occasionally lamb.

There is a choice of vegetables, which you help yourself to, and you can have as much as you want, the roast potatoes are very tasty and well cooked.

The waiting staff are very friendly and quick to serve I have never booked, I have just turned up even on a Sunday and got a table but I get there at midday and while I am there it does get busy.
